The median annual income of a farmworker is \$7,500-well below below the poverty line.

Despite working more than 12 hours per day in the sweltering heat, they receive subpoverty wages.

Due to exhorbitant rent, 10-12 workers often live together in a single rundown trailer.

In extreme cases, workers are held in modern-day slavery and forced to work through violence.

Taco Bell is a major buyer of Florida tomatoes, and as such profits from farmworker poverty and substandard working conditions.

As a major buyer, Taco Bell also has the power and responsibility to demand fair labor standards of its tomato suppliers.
